We will mail you a volunteer packet that consists of an application, health clearance form (that must have a recent TB test done) and Volunteer Handbook must be read. You must complete pages 37-44 prior to attending a monthly meeting/orientation with potential volunteers. This handbook will give you a thorough understanding of Valley Presbyterian Hospital Volunteer Program. We require 120 hours commitment and one 4 hour shift a week. All adults must also have a background check cleared before starting to volunteer and the hospital will pay for this report. Once we confirmed clearance potential candidates will be notified of your first date to start volunteering at Valley Presbyterian Hospital. When all paperwork is completed please call us at 818-902-2932 to set up an appointment for monthly meetings to review and turn in all paperwork.
