



ST 201 Surgical Case Requirements

The EVIT student case requirements during externship are as follows as per their certification guidelines.

Each student, during their extern, must obtain a minimum of 120 cases, 80 cases must be in the first scrub solo role. The first scrub solo role is defined as assuming more than 90% of the responsibility for all aspects of the case.

Within the 80 first scrub role cases, 20 must be in general surgery, 60 cases must be evenly distributed between a minimum of 5 surgical specialties. 15 is the maximum number of cases that can be counted in any one surgical specialty. There should be a maximum of 40 cases in the second scrub role, 10 cases should be in General, and 30 cases distributed throughout the specialties. Up to 10 diagnostic cases and 5 vaginal delivery cases may be counted toward maximum number of second scrub role cases.

Observation cases must be documented, but do not count toward the 120 required cases.

The students are to record all of the cases they participate in regardless of the role they play in their surgical case log and in the Data Arc electronic log system on a daily basis, in order to track the above requirements
