

I got to interview Ms. Rose and it was such a fun thing to do! Just so you know, this is not her first interview.


She has been a teacher for six years, but this is her first year at IGHMS. Ms. Rose became a reading



#### 2021 World Series: Houston Astros vs. Atlanta Braves

After an exciting 2019 season, the Astros were exposed for cheating by their own former pitcher: Mike Fiers. After being on the World Series champs team, the Houston Astros in 2017, he let out the news that they had been cheating in 2017.

Four years later, the Astros made the World Series AGAIN, and everyone wanted the Braves to win it all. Of course, that's exactly what happened.

After a great series, the Braves came away with the title, with Ozzie Albies, and Freddie Freeman both having a great series.

Freeman batted .318 in the series while also posting a

fielding percentage of 1.000 through 44 total chances, and Albies posted an AVG of .238, but had an OBP of .360. Both players led the Braves to their first World Series title since 1995.

On the other hand, the Astros, in their 3rd World Series trip in just 5 years, had a rough time producing runs. Jose Altuve, often regarded as the Astros best player, batted just .222 in 27 at bats , a relatively low number for him, after batting .303 in his previous World Series in 2019 against the Nationals.

After being awarded the ALCS MVP Award, Yordan Alvarez completely fell apart in the World Series, putting up a weak .100 average in 20 at bats. With the Astros offense not showing up, the Braves pulled away and took the series in 6 games.

With another historic World Series in the books, the Braves won their fourth World Series title in franchise history, while the Astros will have to wish for better luck next time.

2021 was a season to remember, and baseball fans can't wait for April!

Do you want to start riding horses? Do you know how to ride? Do I need to buy a horse? These are just some of the questions people may ask when they are just starting to ride horses. In this article I am going to answer these questions and many more that you may have.

You just need to get a riding instructor to help you and a barn to go to. You may not know what a barn is: a barn is a building with dirt on the floor so it's soft for the horses when they get worked. There are structures inside the building that are called stalls. In the stalls there is sawdust on the bottom of the stalls so it's comfortable when the horses want to sleep.

There are barns everywhere in the US, you just have to explore the area to find one. Once you find one, you can schedule what days you will come out to your barn. In my opinion everyone should go out weekly, that way you can get better each time and reduce the chance for you to forget everything. Start by learning how to groom the horse (depending on the barn you go to). Then, learn how to get the horse tacked (again depending on the barn you go to). Your trainer will show you how to get on the horse - how you get on depends on what division you want to ride your horse in because it's a little different for each division.

Once you get your horse out of the stall and to the mounting block (which is a fancy name for step stool) your trainer will help you get on the proper way. Then, you'll learn how to start walking your horse. You'll go on to different gates and eventually over time

you will be ready to maybe start showing. When you

start showing you will need to get a riding suit, which your trainer will help with. From there you will be able to improve your riding abilities and hopefully, when you're ready, you



might win the national and world championship.
