ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS

- Moon Valley High must receive a list of spectators that will be in attendance **24 hours prior to the contest.** (the list must have first and last names of each spectator) Please email your list to Eddie Lopez or Carol Malding (emails are listed above).
- Each player on your roster is allowed 2 parents/guardians (adults) to watch the game.
- Each coach is allowed 2 people to watch the game. (a small child would count as 1 of the 2)
- Each cheerleader is allowed 2 parents/guardians (adults) to watch the game.
- All people listed **must wear a face covering/mask and show ID** in order to come into the game.
- Anyone who comes to the game and is not on the list will be **turned away.**
- Names will **NOT be added/removed** once list is submitted
- Social distancing will be followed when sitting in the bleachers.
- Spectators will need to leave immediately after the game. No gathering.
- Players will not be allowed to gather at the fence to see spectators at the end of the game.
- Admission is free.
- No Snack Bar or vending machines will be available.
- IF WE DO NOT GET A LIST OF SPECTATORS, THEY WILL BE TURNED AWAY.

PARKING

Visiting Teams – Enter through the east gate on Cactus Road near 35th Ave. Drive south into the campus to the bus circle. Teams will drop off in front of the main gym and be directed toward the field.

General Parking – Visitors can park in our stadium parking lot. Enter at 37th Avenue and Cactus Rd.

Officials – Parking will be available in our stadium parking lot.

Athletic Trainer

An Athletic Trainer will be onsite for emergencies and injuries that occur during play. We ask that your athletes get taped before travel, unless you bring your own trainer. **Teams must also supply their own water.**

LOCKER ROOMS

Limited Locker room use will be available. Not at halftime.

There will be limited access to locker rooms. Only 10 athletes at a time, if needed. We ask that your players come dressed in full bottom gear. Otherwise, we can let them in the locker room 10 at a time.

At halftime the visiting team will go to the Softball field bleachers. The team will be escorted by a Moon Valley representative. There will be bathrooms available for the team members only during this time.

Officials – A locker room will be available for officials. Showers will NOT be provided.
